1.	Name of the scheme	:-	The schemes are as follows:- (1) Financial Assistance for Higher Studies and (2) ANM,GNM & Para-Medical Course etc.
1.	Total budget provision	:-	The schemes are as follows:- (1) Rs. 300.00 lakh for Higher Studies and (2) Rs. 200.00 lakh for ANM,GNM & B.Sc Nursing etc.
2.	Physical target	:-	Target is as per requirement submitted by SDWOs.
3.	Objective of the scheme	:-	<p>The scheme is to provide financial assistance for students belonging to the Tea & Ex-Tea Garden Tribes pursuing higher studies like MBBS, MBA Engineering and such other technical/higher education including higher studies in Administration, Medical, Engineering, Law, Research within and outside the State/Country for the students.</p> <p>Further, students of tea & ex-tea garden tribes, pursuing courses of ANM, GNM, B.Sc & M.Sc Nursing etc. are eligible for financial assistance.</p>
4.	Name of the implementing agency	:-	Directorate for Welfare of Tea & Ex-Tea Garden Tribes.
5.	Method of implementation	:-	<p>The Sub-divisional Welfare Officers, calls for applications, and based on the applicants and after due scrutiny select the beneficiaries and submit the lists to the Directorate.</p> <p>The Chairman, State Level Advisory Committee for Tea Tribes Welfare Department approve the lists submitted by the Sub-Divisional Beneficiary Selection Committee.</p> <p>The selected students avail the financial assistance through e-transfer in their banks accounts.</p>
6.	Eligible Criteria	:-	<p>Eligible criteria for Financial Assistance for Higher Studies, as given below:-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be a citizen of India. • Be a permanent resident of Assam and must belong to tea & ex-tea garden tribes. • Must produce Caste certificate. The certifying authority is the Deputy Commissioner of the concerned district and the Director of Tea Welfare, Govt. of Assam will be the countersigning authority. • Must produce admission receipt <p>Application should be submitted <u>through head of the concern institutions</u> with the following information :-</p> <p>(1) <u>Name of the candidate</u>, (2) Age (as on 1st January of that year), (3) Father's name and permanent address, (4) Full correspondence address, (5) <u>Telephone/Mobile No</u>, (6) Percentage of marks in HSLC/HSSLC and above, (7) Name of the course and duration of study undergoing, (8) Amount of annual course fee, (9) Father's/Guardian's annual income (supported by income certificate), (10) Name and address of the institution where studying, (11) Caste certificate (TGL).</p> <p>Eligible criteria for ANM/GNM, B.Sc and M.Sc Nursing etc., as given below:-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be a citizen of India.

			<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Be a permanent resident of Assam and must belongs to tea & ex-tea garden tribes.• Must produce Caste certificate. The certifying authority is the Deputy Commissioner of the concerned district and the Director of Tea Welfare, Govt. of Assam will be the countersigning authority.• For ANM course minimum qualification for selection of candidates is HSSLC (10+2) or equivalent and or as per latest guidelines of Indian Nursing Council (INC).• For GNM courses minimum qualification for selection of candidates is HSSLC (10+2) Science or equivalent and or as per latest guidelines of Indian Nursing Council (INC).• For B. Sc. Nursing minimum qualification for selection of candidates is HSSLC (Science) (10+2) equivalent with Physic, Chemistry, Biology with a minimum 45 % marks in the above mentioned subject taken together SC, ST, OBC/MOBC candidates as per latest guidelines of Indian Nursing Council (INC).• Age : ANM students have to be in the age limit of 17-24 years on 1st January of the year of Admission. Upper age limit is relaxable by 3 years for SC. ST, OBC/MOBC candidates.• Age : GNM/B.Sc. Nursing etc. course students have to be in the age limit of 17-24 years on 1st January of the year of Admission. Upper age limit is relax able by 5 years for SC. ST, OBC/MOBC candidates.• Only Female candidates are to apply.• Physically Handicapped are also to apply.
